**Refugee Resettlement Program** (*located at Catholic Center 1400 N. Meridian Street, Indianapolis, IN 46202*)  
The Refugee Resettlement Program of Catholic Charities Indianapolis is helping hundreds of newly arrived refugee families this year in Indianapolis. Volunteers are needed with trucks to pick-up and deliver household furniture and vehicles to transport clients to/from appointments.

Currently our Crisis Office needs:

- Non-perishable, nutritious food items such as: tuna, pork and beans, spaghetti, spaghetti sauce (in cans), soup, peanut butter, cereal, canned stews, rice and rice mixes, pasta mixes.
- Laundry detergent, toilet paper, shampoo, deodorant, dish detergent, shaving cream.
- Children’s clothing, men’s pants, men’s shoes and new socks for children and adults.
